Brandon Area Community Foundation Invests More Than \$800,000 in Regional Community Organizations

The Brandon Area Community Foundation is celebrating its 60th year of operations by distributing more than \$800,000 to 46 successful grant applicants.

The BACF Community Grants program provided funding to qualified applicants from the BACF's granting area in the following fields of interest: Arts & Culture, Community Development, Education, Environment, Health and Wellness, and Recreation.

This year, there were a record 96 applications, from which 46 were selected for funding. A complete list of funded activities is attached. Projects must generally be completed within a year of the grant award. Almost half of the funded projects are located outside Brandon, and several grants support activities that serve residents of both Brandon and the surrounding communities.

"Thanks to donor generosity, we were able to direct more funds to our community grants program, and this year were able to nearly double the amount of awarded grants and increase our funding by approximately 30 per cent over last year," said Dean Hammond, the volunteer Chair of the BACF Grants Committee.

"Over the past 60 years we have funded hundreds of projects throughout our granting area," Hammond said. "We asked the Brandon and Westman community to come forward with a strong set of applications this year, and they did that. Our committee had an excellent selection of quality submissions from which to choose, and we thank everyone for the work they put into their applications." The Foundation and grant recipients will provide regular updates on social media about the various projects over the coming year.

FOUNDATION FACTS: Since 1965, the Brandon and Area Community Foundation (BACF) has invested nearly \$13 million dollars in numerous community organizations throughout southwestern Manitoba. Starting with a modest \$25,000 gift, the organization celebrates its 60th year of operations with approximately \$28 million invested in more than 100 endowed funds.

This legacy commitment from donors past and present now allows the Foundation to grant approximately \$1.2 million each year from community and donor-directed funds to registered charities and community groups that demonstrate a defined need. We also work with donors to create special purpose funds, donor-directed funds or scholarship funds based on areas of interest.
